Business Jet Center to Host NBAA Regional Forum

**Dallas Love Field Facility Prepares for Record Attendance at
National Business Aviation Association's One-Day Event**

April 13, 2006—Love Field, Dallas, TX...Business Jet Center, a leading provider of Fixed Base Operation (FBO) services at Dallas Love Field, will host a National Business Aviation Association (NBAA) Regional Forum on Thursday, April 13, 2006, from 9:00 AM – 4:00 PM CDT. One of only three FBOs nationally to be selected to host a regional forum in 2006, Business Jet Center is expecting more than 1,200 attendees and 75 exhibitors, both new records for the event.

NBAA Business Aviation Regional Forums bring business aircraft owners, operators, manufacturers, customers and other industry personnel together for a one-day event at some of the best airports and FBOs in the nation. Information sessions will focus on very light jets (VLJ's), aircraft acquisition, safety best practices and legislative priorities for the business aviation community. More than 25 business aircraft will be on display at the event.

In addition, Federal Aviation Administration (FAA), Air Traffic Control (ATC) management personnel and NBAA employees will answer questions about air traffic management procedures in the Southwest. This is the second time Business Jet Center has been selected to host this event.

“Business aviation plays an important role in how Dallas area companies connect with their customers both domestically and internationally,” said Stephanie Jordan, General Manager, Business Jet Center. “This forum presents an opportunity for all those involved in this process to come together in a learning and informational exchange environment.”

Jordan said much attention will likely be given this year to discussions surrounding the charter aircraft industry, which is designed to give business travelers more efficient access to airports not serviced directly by commercial airline flights, and to the emergence of VLJ's, which will bring the productivity and efficiency advantages offered by business aviation to many types of companies and organizations. Some of these new aircraft will be included in the display at Thursday's Regional Forum.

Located on 24 acres at the North end of Love Field, Business Jet Center has 178,000 sq. ft. of hangar and terminal office space. Recognized annually as one of the top five FBO locations nationally in prominent aviation publications, Business Jet Center has been named as one of the top 70 best places to work in the Metroplex.
